The biodiversity and richness of our geographical location are subject to the impact of our tourist activity. We are committed to preserving this exceptional environment, and this policy is a sign of our active commitment to protecting it.

Here are our actions and commitments.

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WE ARE WORKING HARD ON ENERGY.

Saison 2025

Choosing renewable energy, electricity and reducing our consumption:

Our EDF contract is 100% renewable energy. Within the estate, we encourage eco and electric transport for staff. Charging stations are available for electric vehicles. We have installed bike racks to encourage their use on the campsite. All the lighting in the park is LED. Solar panels produce electricity and programmers/variators limit our consumption. Eco-responsible information is available to our customers.

2 WE PRESERVE WATER.

Recycling and reducing

our consumption!

Water from the aquatic area is recycled to irrigate the green spaces. Our plants are adapted to the climate and our green spaces are mulched to limit evaporation. We have installed water flow reducers throughout the park. In the sanitary facilities, the Presto system limits consumption. From 2025, new 'intelligent' watering systems will enable us to save water, monitor consumption to the nearest litre and adapt automatically according to the weather. Our laundry is an eco-consumer and we are paying particular attention to water leaks by installing over 60 smart meters.

3 WE TAKE CARE OF BIODIVERSITY.

Preserving spaces and building partnerships.

Our green spaces are free from chemical treatments and their systematic mulching encourages soil life. The plant species selected are melliferous and encourage foragers. Our Permaculture area is a sanctuary dedicated to nature, and we have installed 3 beehives. Most of our cleaning products are eco-labelled or eco-certified. Finally, we carry out eco-citizen clean-up operations with the Project Rescue Ocean association.

WE LIMIT OUR WASTE.

At Les Sablons, we recycle! We have numerous selective sorting areas for our customers, as well as an inhouse collection system. All our restaurant packaging is recyclable. End-of-life electrical appliances are systematically recycled. We compost green waste, as well as the peelings from our restaurants, our customers' biowaste and unsold groceries. By 2025, bio-bins will be available directly in each rental unit.

5 WE RAISE AWARENESS AMONG OUR CUSTOMERS.

Back to nature & children, tomorrow's ambassadors!

Our Permaculture area raises awareness of nature and the mini-farm promotes respect for the animal kingdom. In 2025, we are joining forces with Stade Formation to train activity leaders who are committed to sustainable development.

6 WE DEVELOP WELL-BEING. Taking care of people!

Many of our facilities offer wellness services for our guests and staff: we have a massage parlour, a beauty and hairdressing salon, solariums, yoga and relaxation classes. Three hectares are devoted to sports and nature activities. Three hectares are dedicated to sports and nature activities.

7 WE WORK LOCALLY.

Our partners are mainly local, responsible and eco-responsible companies.

This year we have introduced a sustainable purchasing policy to encourage environmentally sustainable suppliers, products and services. We sell berlingots from Pézenas, local Alaryk beer and wines from the region... The restaurant's fresh produce is sourced as close to home as possible. We also work with a local E.S.A.T., which enables people with disabilities to work while benefiting from medical, social and educational support. 2,000m² of market gardens also supply our catering centre with seasonal fruit and vegetables.

8 AND NEXT YEAR? WE'RE COMMITTED !

Lighting in the new neighbourhoods will be solar-powered, and each neighbourhood will be equipped with an electrical load-shedding system.

We are continuing to implement preventive and corrective measures to preserve and promote biodiversity.
