

AQUATIC PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations have been established for the benefit of all users of the aquatic centre to assure the safe operation of the pool facilities. It establishes the conditions of use as well as the prescriptions that must be observed in order to ensure the smooth functioning of the establishment and the security of all users. It does not obstruct the application of the laws in force.

The Pool Manager or their designated assistants are responsible for the operation of the pools. Their instruction must be followed at all timers.

1. GENERAL RULES / ADMISSION POLICIES

Article 1:

Access to the aquatic centre is exclusively restricted to the person staying in the Camping Les Sablons.

Users MUST wear their Sablons wristband at ALL TIME when entering the pools.

Article 2:

The aquatic centre is open all day **from 10:00 am to 07:00 pm.** Closing of the slides at 06:45 pm.

During high season (from July to August) the aquatic center is open all day **from 10:00 am to 07:30 pm.** Closing of the slides at 07:15 pm. On Saturdays, closing of aquatic areas at 8:30 p.m.

When closing the pool a final whistle will be given to notify the users. As soon as this signal is heard, nobody is allowed access to the beach, or the pools and swimming is forbidden.

Article 3:

No person within the pool grounds shall behave in such a manner as to jeopardize the safety and health of himself/herself and others. Such

behavior, including abusive or profane language, shall be ground for expulsion.

Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted in the pool complex or in the surrounding area.

Any person having a skin disease, communicable disease, or who is wearing any kind of bandage or Band-Aid will not be permitted in the pools.

Pets are not permitted in the pool complex.

Article 4: Children ten (10) years old and under must be directly supervised at pool side by a responsible adult, parents and legal tutors must watch and supervise their children.



2. ATTIRE

Article 5: Pool users must wear swimming suits upon entry into the pool. A correct and decent apparel is required and a proper behavior is expected at all time and everywhere. For health and hygiene reasons only bathing slips (= boxer, jammer) will be allowed for men.

Clothing such as T-shirts, cut-offs, gym shorts, swimming shorts, bathing trunks, and underwear is NOT permitted as swimwear. Any attire like a short (or clothes) is FORBIDDEN.

Article 6: Shower with soap, footbath are compulsory before going inside the pools.

3. BEHAVIOR

Article 7: **Diving is forbidden** in all the pools.

Article 8: Pushing someone in the water is forbidden.

Article 9: No prolonged underwater swimming for time and or distance.

Article 10: Aquatoon: Child under 10 years old must be supervised in the water by an

adult

Article 11: It is forbidden to use loud music players or other devices producing loud sounds.

4. GROUPS ACCESS - MINI CLUB

Article 12:

To be admitted by the pools, groups must:

Introduce themselves upon arrival to the Pool Manager or one of his assistants. Be organized as follow:

- A maximum of 40 kids
- Groups with children above 6 years of age must provide one adult for every eight (8) children in the water
- Groups with children under 6 years of age must provide one adult for every five (5) children in the water.

Article 13:

Groups entering the establishment are under full responsibility of their supervisors. The Pool Manager or the Pool Assistants, lifeguards, or any employees of the camping working by the pool CANNOT be held responsible in any case of the behavior or acts of the people within a group.

5. HEALTH / SAFETY POLICIES

Article 14: List of interdictions:

* No reserving the sun loungers (if you leave pool area don't leave your towel).



- * No playing with ball.
- * No climbing or overcoming any kind of separation.
- * No entering restricted areas signaled by a sign or a note.
- * No walk with shoes inside the showers or on the pool decks.
- * No smoking within the pool area (except in the solarium).
- * **No eating** or drinking outside designated area (located outside the pool area) this rule applies to young children and babies.
- * No running on the pool decks.
- * Spitting, spouting water, blowing nose, urinating, or defecating in the pool is prohibited.
- * Glass containers, alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the pool complex.
- * All refuse and waste papers must be deposited in designated receptacles (dolphins). Please recycle.
- * Inflated boats, and rafts are not permitted in the main pools. Small toys may be allowed in the Tot Pool at the Manager's discretion.
- * Simulate drowning is forbidden.
- * No damaging the facilities or the equipment will be tolerated.
- * No behavior bothering the users and the smooth functioning of the establishment will be tolerated.
- * No climbing on shoulders

Article 15: Sanctions

Employees and especially lifeguards have all authority to make sure the above safety and health rules and regulations are implemented. Any user with a disturbing behavior will be escorted to the exit.

People responsible of damages will have to pay the amount of the reparations to the Camping Les Sablons.

Article 16: WATER SLIDES

- Children under 1m20 cannot use the slides.
- Authorized positions are: sitting, feet first only, on back.
- Only one person on the slide at a time.
- Before using the slide respect the light signal, "red" stop and wait, "green" proceed for the slide.
- Children under 1m20 are tolerated on the Pentaglisse, but must be supervised by a responsible adult during the ride down.

Article 17: AQUATOON

- Children **under 1m** cannot use the Aquatoon slides.
- Children under ten years old must be supervised by a responsible adult.
- Get out of the way guickly when you land in the water from the slides.
- Don't dive, jump or climb.
- No sun loungers around the AQUATOON.

Article 18: Thunderstorm

In the case of the thunderstorm, people MUST evacuate the pools immediately.
